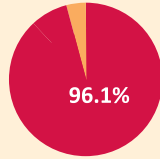

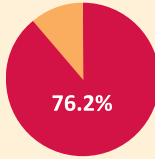

- 96.1%** of employed women are in informal employment, compared to **76.2%** of employed men.

- Women in Rangpur spend, on average, **24.7%** of their time on unpaid domestic and care work while men spend **2.8%** of their time on the same. This means that women spend nearly nine times as much time on unpaid domestic and care work as men.

- 22%** of currently married women with **cash earnings** make decisions independently on how their earnings will be used, while **67%** decide jointly with their husband.

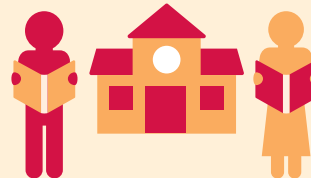

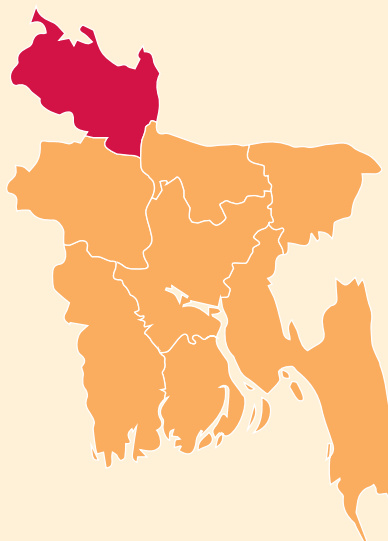

- Of the **1820** people who live with disabilities in Rangpur as a result of natural hazards **987 (54.2%)** are men and **834 (45.8%)** are women.

Gender-Based Violence

- Based on local context, **74%** of all ever-married women aged 15 years and older experienced physical, sexual, psychological, or economic violence by their partner in their lifetime and **53%** experienced it in the last 12 months.

- Based on local context, **14.1%** of ever-partnered women and girls aged 15 years and older experienced physical violence, **9.1%** experienced sexual violence, **20.8%** emotional violence, **14.6%** experienced economic violence, and **47.3%** faced controlling behaviour by their intimate partner in the previous 12 months.

- **7%** of ever-married women who experience intimate partner violence take legal action.

- **2.9%** of women in Rangpur reported experiences of selected forms of technology-facilitated gender-based violence in the last **12** months, and **5%** reported experiences in their lifetime.

- **9.5%** of women between the ages of 20-24 were married before their 15th birthday.
